REVIEW OF BOOK OF THE MONTH

This month's review is by Laura Mushkat on "A Nun in the Closet".

She writes: A "Nun in the Closet" is about the adventure of two cloistered nuns who must travel from Pennsylvania hundreds of miles to upstate New York. They were chosen by the members of their Abbey to go because of a letter the nuns received telling them someone they never heard of had left them land. They have to learn to drive for the first time and deal with outsiders who are very strange to them.



They eventually get to what proves to be a great estate. There is a large, furnished house with many secrets and a lot of land. They find and deal with a hurt man in a closet and he is a mystery himself. Add to that the hippies and farm workers who live on the land, visits from gangsters, the law, and the things that have to be dealt with. Among these strange things are why they received the estate, murder, and a lot of hidden money. The two sisters prove to be very resourceful in this strange new world and accomplish all their goals.

The only disappointment is that the book seems to end much too soon and that there never were more adventures written. You want to be friends with Sister John and Sister Hyacinthe.

It is very well written and most unusual given the character of the nuns.
